Warning

- ALWAYS use cabinets or stands or mounting methods recommended by the manufacturer of the television set.
- ALWAYS use furniture that can safely support the television set.

- ALWAYS educate children about the dangers of climbing on furniture to reach the television set or its controls.
- ALWAYS route cords and cables connected to your television so they cannot be tripped over, pulled or grabbed.

Product

- Do not block or cover the ventilation openings on the back cover.
- Do not push objects of any kind into this unit through the cabinet slots as they could touch the current carrying parts or short-circuit parts, resulting in fire, electric shock, or damage to the unit.
- Do not attempt to open the cabinet as this may cause damage. There are no parts inside you can service by yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Do not touch the screen surface with fingers as this may scratch or mar the TV screen.

Power and Plug

- Unplug the set under the following conditions:
 - If the set will not be used for a long period of time.
 - If the power cord or the power outlet/plug is damaged.
- Follow the instructions to install and adjust the product. Adjust those controls that are covered in these operating instructions as improper adjustment of other controls may result in damage. If this happens, unplug the set and refer to the service personnel.
- If the set is subject to impact or has been dropped and the cabinet has been damaged.
- Where the mains plug or an appliance coupler is used as disconnect device, the disconnect device shall remain readily operable.

Important Safety Precautions

Power Cord and Signal Cable

- Do not allow anything to rest on or roll over the power cord and the signal cable.
- Protect the power cord and the signal cable from being trampled.
- Do not overload the power cord or the power outlet.
- Do not expose the power cord and the signal cable to moisture.

Use Environment

- Do not place the set on an unstable cart, stand, or table.
- Place the set on a place that allows good ventilation.
- Do not use the set near damp, and cold areas.
- Do not expose the set to excessive heat such as direct sunlight, fire, or the like and no naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on the apparatus.
- Do not expose the set to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the apparatus.
- Do not use the set in dusty environments.
- Operating Temperature: 5°C to 35°C (41°F to 95°F)
Operating Humidity: 20% to 80%, non-condensing
Storage Temperature: -15°C to 45°C (5°F to 113°F)

Cleaning

- Dust the set by wiping the screen and the cabinet with a soft, clean cloth or some special liquid cleaner.
 - Do not apply excessive force to the screen when cleaning.
 - Do not use water or other chemical cleaner to clean the screen as this may damage the surface of the TV screen.
- All other safety instructions about our TV sets are also applicable here. Wall mount bracket not included.

(**Note:** Certain TV models are not designed to be mounted to the wall.)

Precautions For Using Remote Control

- Use the remote control by pointing it towards the remote sensor. The items between the remote control and the remote sensor will interfere in normal operation.
- Do not make remote control vibrate violently, or splash liquid on the remote control, or put the remote control in a high humidity place.
- Do not place remote control under direct sunlight, which will cause deformation of the unit by heat.
- When the remote sensor is under direct sunlight or strong lighting, the remote control will not work. In this case, please change the lighting or TV's position, or operate the remote control closer to the remote sensor.
- Before Bluetooth searching, please make sure you have turned external Bluetooth devices in the pairing mode. For the Bluetooth remote control supplied with the TV (may not be available in your region), you can press **◀** and **HOME** buttons together to open its pairing mode. For other Bluetooth devices, please read their own instruction manuals for opening the pairing mode.

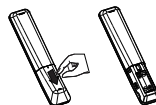
Precautions For Using Battery

Improper using of the battery will cause leakage. So, please follow the methods given below and use carefully.

1. Please note the batteries' polarity to avoid short circuit.
2. When the battery's voltage is insufficient, which affects the use range, you should replace the battery. Remove the batteries from the remote control unit, if you do not intend to use it for a long time.
3. Do not use different types of batteries (e.g., Manganese and Alkaline batteries) together.
4. Do not put the battery into fire, and charge or decompose the battery.
5. Please dispose of batteries in compliance with the relevant environmental protection regulations.
6. **WARNING:** The batteries (battery pack or batteries installed) should not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire, etc.

Install Remote Control Batteries

Place two AAA size batteries in the remote control's battery compartment, making sure to match the polarity markings inside the compartment.



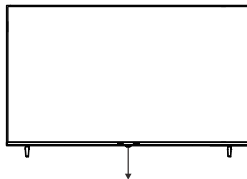

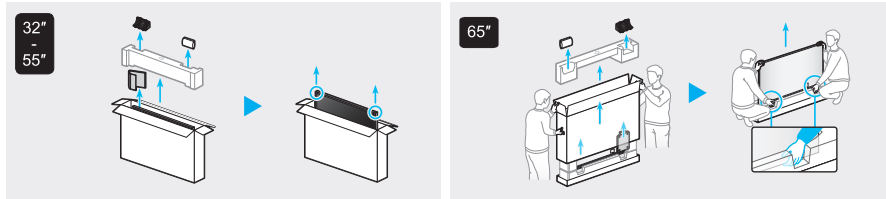

TV Install And Connect



Set your TV

To put your TV on a firm place which can bear the weight of the TV.

To avoid danger, please don't position the TV near water or heating place (such as light, candle, heating machine), do not block the ventilation at the back of TV.

Connect antenna and power

1. Connect the antenna cable to the antenna socket on the back of the TV.

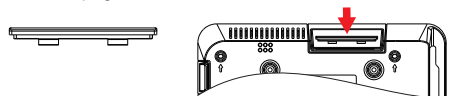
2. To plug the power cord of TV (AC 100-240V~ 50/60Hz).

The attached power cord is for this model only

Turn on TV

3. Connect the power supply, enter the standby mode (red light), press the power button of the TV or the power button on the remote control to turn on the TV

Note: If the model has a CI card slot on its top, a silicone plug for the CI card slot can be found in the accessory bag (for models without CI card slot, there is no such silicone plug), please insert the silicone plug into the slot when the CI card is not in use.

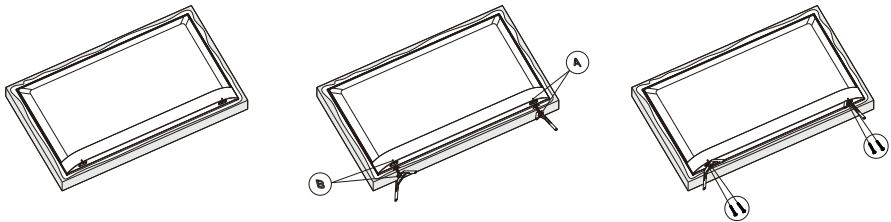
TV Stand Installation Instructions

Stand Installation

Step 1: Take out the TV and carefully put it (screen downward) on a stable and flat table with a soft cloth or cushion on it.

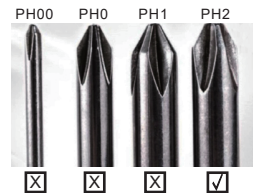
Step 2: Please check to make sure there is the same mark (A/B) on the TV back and the correct stand. This step is not available for the stands without any mark on it, or not available for the TV with one stand only.

Step 3: Fix the stands to the TV by using the matching screws provided in the box. The stands may vary depending on the region or model.



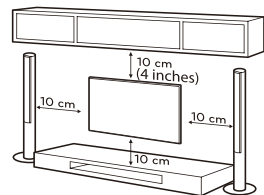
Suggestion:

To make it more convenient for base installation and to avoid any risk of scratches and damage, we advise you using the type of PH2 screwdriver.



Mounting on a Wall

- An optional wall mount can be used with your television. Consult with your local dealer to purchase the recommended wall mount bracket. Carefully attach the wall mount bracket at the rear of the TV. Install the wall mount bracket on a solid wall perpendicular to the floor. If you are attaching the TV to other building materials, please contact qualified personnel to install the wall mount. Detailed instructions will be included with the wall mount. Please use a wall mount bracket where the device is adequately secured to the wall with enough space to allow connectivity to external devices.

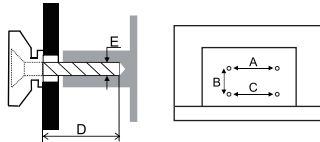

- Disconnect the power before moving or installing the TV. Otherwise electric shock may occur.
- Remove the stand before installing the TV on a wall mount by attaching the stand in reverse.
- If you install the TV on a ceiling or slanted wall, it may fall and result in severe personal injury. Use an authorised wall mount, and contact the local dealer or qualified personnel. Otherwise it will not be covered by the warranty.
- Do not over tighten the screws as this may cause damage to the TV, and void your warranty.
- To prevent injury, this apparatus must be securely attached to the wall in accordance with the installation instructions.

Mounting on a Wall

- Use the screws and wall mounts that meet the following specifications. Any damages or injuries by misuse or using an improper accessory are not covered by the warranty.
- Wall-mounted screw: 22-24 inch M4, 28-75 inch M6, 77 inch M8, 85 inch M6, 100 inch M8.
- Note: don't hang at an angle to avoid the risk of falling off.

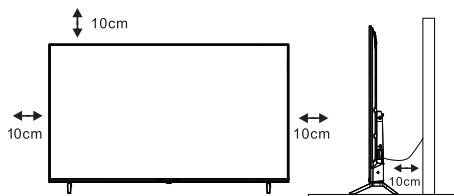

2. For the TV sets with terminals towards the wall, in order to leave enough space to use the terminals, a plastic spacer is needed together with each screw to fix the wall mount. It is a small hollow pillar, the height of which is ≥ 30 mm.

Install Display on solid horizontal surface such as a table or desk. For ventilation, leave a space of at least 10cm free all around the set. To prevent any fault and unsafe situations, please do not place any objects on top of the set. This apparatus can be used in tropical and/or moderate climates. Fix the rear of enclosure to wall (only for some countries).

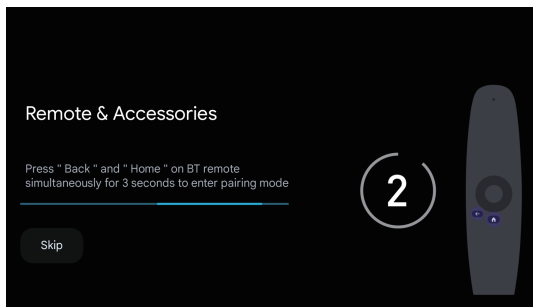

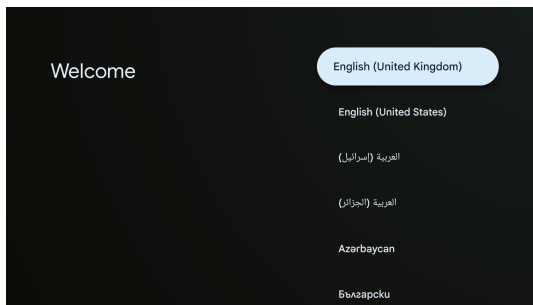
1.1 Pairing Bluetooth Remote

2. Select the 'Skip' icon to skip the pairing mode.



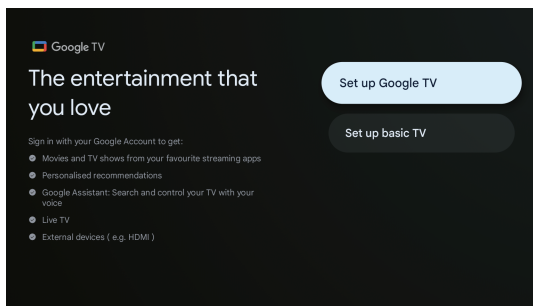

Near Field Voice

1. Near Field Microphone

2. Mic Button of Near Field Voice Function

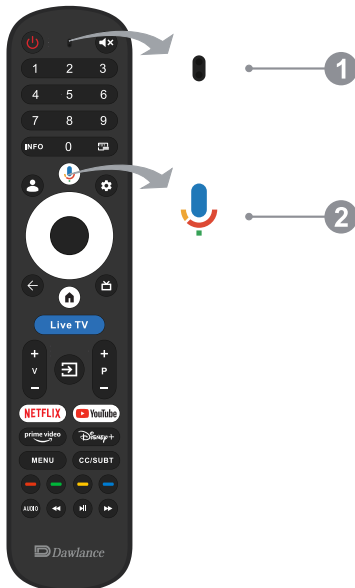

In settings, please refer to the following steps to pair the remote control:

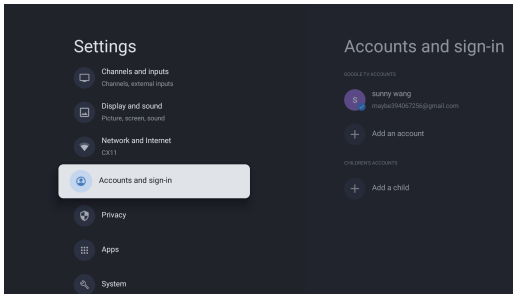
1. Select "**HOME** → Settings → Remotes & Accessories".

4. It will show "Paired" after Bluetooth remote control is paired with the TV successfully.



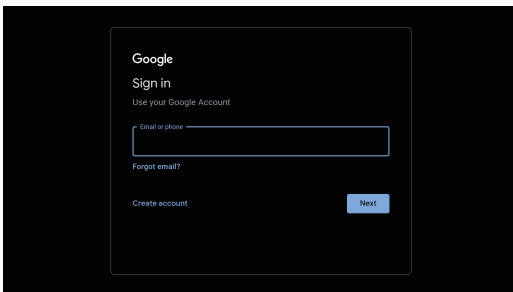

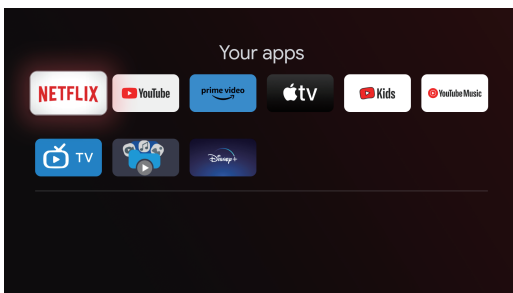

Help

No power	● Check if the AC cord of TV is plugged in or not. If there's still no power, please disconnect the plug, and reconnect to the socket after 60 seconds. Turn the power back on.
Signal not received properly	● Double or phantom images may appear on your TV if there are high buildings or mountains close to where you are. You can adjust the image thru manual operation: consult instruction of vernier regulation, or adjust the direction of the external antenna. ● If you use an indoor antenna, signal reception may be more difficult under certain circumstances. Adjust the direction of the antenna for optimum reception. If this does not improve reception, you may have to switch to an external antenna.
No picture	● Check if the antenna at the back of the TV is connected properly. ● View other channels to see if the problem still occurs.
Video appears with no audio	● Try increasing the volume. ● Check if the TV's sound is on mute or not.
Audio is present, but video does not appear or is discolored	● Try adjusting the contrast and brightness.
Static noise affects video and audio quality	● Check if the antenna at the back of the TV is connected properly.
Broken lines on screen	● Electrical appliances such as hair dryers or vacuums etc. may be interfering with your TV set. Switch these appliances off.
Remote doesn't work	● Make sure the plastic bag which came with the remote control is removed. Try using the remote in a shorter distance from the TV. Check if the placement of the batteries is correct, or try using new batteries with the remote control. ● The TV will go into Standby mode if it receives no response in a few minutes.
No video (PC mode)	● Please check if the cable is connected to the VGA port correctly, or if the cable is bent in some places.
Vertical line blinking (PC Mode)	● Enter the main menu, and adjust the vertical placement to eliminate the vertical line.
Horizontal tearing (PC Mode)	● Adjust the horizontal placement of the screen to clear any horizontal lines.
Screen is too bright or dark (PC Mode)	● Adjust the brightness or contrast in the main menu.
No response from the PC	● Check if the PC's display resolution is set to a compatible resolution for the TV.
Lines appearing when a device is connected to the RCA port	● Make sure you are using a cable in good quality.
Problems are unresolved	● Unplug the power cable and wait for 30 seconds, then reconnect to the socket. If problems still persist, do not attempt to repair the TV by yourself. Kindly contact the service center.

Do not leave your TV displaying a static image, whether it is from a paused video, menu screen, etc. for an extended period of time, doing so will damage the display and may cause image burn-in.

Problems & Solutions

Note: Problems & solutions 1 to 2 are for the TV models which have network functions, so users of non-connected TV models can disregard them.

1. Fail to link to the network.

- Check if your TV is connected with the network;
- Reboot your TV;
- Consult your Internet service provider, to confirm if access of your router is supported. Refer to the operation manual of your router, and activate its DHCP function after linking the network to your TV.
- Make sure your TV is connected to a router, and make sure your router is powered on. Check that your router/modem has an Internet connection, and that your Ethernet cables/wireless connection is OK. Test your connection with a computer to make sure it is OK. Should the problem persist, contact customer service.
- Check if TV system time is correct or not. Sometimes TV system time is synchronized to the wrong time from abnormal broadcast signal. In this case, please set system time manually.

2. The video could not be played smoothly.

- Videos from your USB flash drive --- It may be caused by abnormal data transmission, or its code rate is far beyond the supported formats of this TV set.
- Videos downloaded from Internet, or online videos.
 - a. It may be caused by the lower bandwidth of your network. A high network speed is required to handle online videos.
 - b. Peak Internet usage times may affect the bandwidth.
 - c. Check if any other computers on the same network are also operating, as they may be using up bandwidth. Especially if they are downloading or playing online videos.
 - d. The video may not be smooth itself, it is not the problem of your TV or network.

3. When two portable hard drives are connected with the TV at the same time, they will not be recognized sometimes.

- All portable hard drives consume a lot of power, which may result in power supply problems. We recommend inserting only one hard drive, or a low power consumption portable hard drive.

4. The video from a portable hard drive (USB) is playing with no sound.

- The audio format of the video in your portable hard drive is not supported by the TV player.

5. Some videos fail to play.

- The formats of the videos may not be supported by the TV, especially videos shot by certain kinds of cameras, generally with their private protocol of

formats, which are not compatible with your TV.

6. Video stops playing midway.

- Mistakes may occur when videos are copied or compressed, so they may automatically stop playing during playback.

7. What should I pay attention to, when I do software updating?

- No power cuts when software updating;
- Avoid any operations with your remote control when software updating;
- Depending on your Internet connection speed, the software updating process may take some time.

8. There are no distinct changes of TV interface after software updating.

- Under certain conditions, software updating may not only update or add new functions but also improve the performance of the TV set, without distinct changes of interface. Also, there may be no changes to the user interface at all.

9. What should I do when software updating process stops due to a sudden power-off?

- If you do software updating by USB, do not pluck the USB drive from your TV, and restart your TV to continue software updating; If you do software updating by Network, also restart your TV and check if it is functioning correctly.

10. With a USB device being inserted into the TV in advance, I am prompted that no USB devices are detected after I access Media, why?

- There may be something wrong with your portable hard drive(s), damaged or with low voltage. It's recommended to provide an additional power supply to the hard drive(s).

11. External device cannot be recognized.

- Some external devices (e.g. webcam, smart phone, tablet, game handle, and external wireless adapter) may not be compatible with the TV and cannot be supported for certain functions (wireless display, gesture control, face recognition, if any). Please try a similar device. If it does not work, contact your local dealer.

12. Voice search does not work.

- Check if your remote control has been successfully paired with your TV.
- Check if the language setting is correct.
- Check if Google server is available and stable.

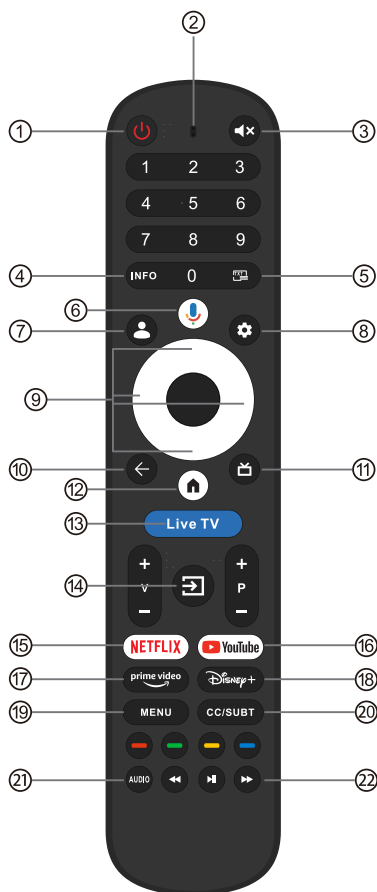
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Remote Control

- ① Switches the TV between on and standby mode.
- ② Indicator light
- ③ Mute or restore your TV sound.
- ④ **INFO**: Displays the present channel information such as the current time and channel name.
- ⑤ **TEXT**: Press to enter Teletext when play the program.
- ⑥ **Google Assistant**:
Talk to Google to control your TV using your voice.
- ⑦ **Profiles**: Switch between profiles.
- ⑧ **Setting**: In the HOME page, this button is "Dashboard" function. On the Live TV, this button is "Menu" function.
- ⑨ **Navigation buttons**: Cursor UP/LEFT/RIGHT/DOWN.
- ⑩ **Back**: Press to move back through menus.
